

Technical Cutting Competition

The competition is inspired by the avant-garde style, characterized by a bold approach to hairstyle forms, using contrasts of volume, shape, and color. These hairstyles highlight a perfectly defined haircut line with a dominant shape that reflects the precision of scissor or clipper movement. They can feature elements of modern-hair contrasts, creating a unique and creative look. This approach exemplifies mastery in hairstyling and sets trends in modern hairdressing and art.

Regulations

1. The competition involves creating a "technical cut" hairstyle.
2. Participants must prepare the complete styling of their model for the competition.
3. The haircutting and styling process should be completed within 40 minutes on stage.
4. Participants must be at least 18 years old.
5. The winner will be the participant with the highest score from the jury.
6. Participants must bring their own models (female models must be at least 16 years old). Each participant is responsible for ensuring their model meets the competition's rules.
7. Models must be dressed in accordance with the competition theme, with makeup already finished before the event. Only hairstyles are created during the competition. Note: Makeup can be done by a third party prior to the competition.
8. Models enter the stage with their hair brushed back—straight and dry.
9. Participants will be disqualified for not adhering to the competition time, pre-preparing parts of the hairstyle, or creating a hairstyle inconsistent with the theme. Note: Cutting must be performed on both wet and dry hair. Allowed tools: combs, round and flat brushes, hairdryers, and sprayers. The model's hair color can be prepared before the competition.
10. Allowed styling products: mousse, hairspray, gloss spray, pomade, paste, wax, talc, hair powders, and gel.
11. Allowed tools: straighteners, wavers, curling irons, crimpers, and hairdryers. Hair extensions are not allowed.
12. Forbidden styling products: coloring gels, spray colors, coloring mousses.
13. Time limit: 40 minutes for the hairstyle, followed by a 5-minute setup for model presentation (this time does not include finishing the hairstyle). Note: During the competition, participants must remain on stage until the hairstyle and styling time ends unless allowed by judges.
14. The hairstyle must be completed solely during the competition.
15. The competition hairstyle can employ any hairstyling technique but without coloring during the cutting and styling process.
16. Participants must provide their own tools and materials.
17. After the time ends, participants leave their station. If finished early, participants raise their hand to indicate completion, prepare the model for jury evaluation (5 minutes), and leave the station.
18. The jury consists of three main judges and two assistant judges. Scoring is open and conducted at the model's station. Categories include timing, makeup, and hairstyle

consistency with the theme (technical cut). Judges assess independently, without consultation.

19. Negative points can be awarded for rule violations, use of prohibited items, starting work before the official start, or continuing after the time ends. If points are tied, the faster participant wins. Judges can issue a red card for severe violations, disqualifying the participant.
