

## Flat Top Hairstyle Competition

### Regulations

1. The competition involves creating a "Flat Top" hairstyle.
2. Maximum time: 40 minutes.
3. Participants must be at least 18 years old.
4. Participants are allowed to receive technical guidance from a coach (the coach must be registered with the jury chairman before the competition).
5. The winner will be the participant with the highest jury score.
6. Participants compete with their own models. Each participant is responsible for ensuring their model complies with the rules.
7. Pre-haircut length:
  - Top: minimum 8 cm.
  - Sides: minimum 2 cm.
8. Post-haircut length:
  - Sides: 0-0.5 mm.
  - Top: minimum 2 cm.
  - The top must form a perfect square when viewed from side to side, and a sloped front to back (e.g., psycho-flat) is acceptable.
9. After the haircut, sides may be shaved to zero with smooth transitions (fades). The top must be shortened by at least 1 cm from its initial length.
10. Models with signs of prior preparation will be eliminated, and participants will be disqualified.
11. Allowed tools: clippers, edgers, razors, scissors, thinning shears, hairdryers, spray bottles, combs, Chinese knives, and styling brushes.
12. Allowed styling products: pomades, pastes, waxes, hairspray, talc, and hair powders.
13. Forbidden tools: combs with levels, straighteners, wavers, curling irons, and round brushes.
14. Forbidden products: colored powders, gels, sprays, and mousses; any hair coloring is prohibited.
15. Time limit: 40 minutes.
16. After the time ends, participants must leave their workstation.
17. Participants who finish early must raise their hand, prepare their model for jury evaluation, and then leave their station.
18. The jury consists of three main judges and two assistants.
19. Scoring is open and performed at the model's station. Categories include:
  - Execution time.
  - Contours.
  - Styling in line with the theme (Square Flat Top).
  - Finishing touches.
  - Outfit consistent with the theme.
  - Scores are awarded independently, without jury consultation.
20. The jury can award negative points for:
  - Rule violations.
  - Using prohibited items.
  - Starting work early or continuing after time ends.

- Preparing hair in an unauthorized manner before the competition.

#### In Case of a Tie

The participant who completed their hairstyle faster will win.

#### Disqualification

A red card will disqualify participants for early starts or prohibited actions during the competition.
