

TASK

Participants are required to create an avant-garde men's hairstyle that aligns with the canon of men's hairdressing, adapted to the shape of the head and face.

GUIDELINES

- Time: 40 minutes.
 - In the "Skin Fade" competition, the jury evaluates haircutting, styling, shaping, hair arrangement, beard trimming, and attire.
 - Hair: The model should have dry hair combed backward.
 - Top: minimum length before cutting is 10 cm.
 - Back and sides: minimum length before cutting is 2 cm.
 - After the haircut, there must be clear tapering from the shortest hair (0 mm) to the longest. The contours at the nape, around the ears, and beard must not be pre-prepared, marked, or shaved.
 - After cutting: Top hair should be a minimum of 5 cm. The back and sides can be tapered using three techniques: scissors, clippers, or razor shaved to zero. The nape and contours may be tapered or shaved to zero.
 - The top must be cut using scissors.
 - Styling should be done using a hairdryer and a styling brush.
 - Hair Color: The hair may be pre-dyed.
 - Beard: The beard can be prepared before the competition. While trimming the beard and mustache is not part of the task, it may be assessed as part of the overall styling.
 - Attire: The model can wear any outfit that adheres to men's fashion and ethical standards. Clothing will be evaluated as part of the overall styling.
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CRITERIA

The jury may select one, two, or three winners for first, second, and third places respectively. The judging panel evaluates:

1. Hair tapering.
2. Cleanliness of the work.
3. Finishing between hair and beard.
4. Styling.
5. Shape from all angles.
6. Clothing matching the overall look.

A Control Committee oversees the competition rules and assigns negative points for violations. These are reported to the judging panel, which will consider the deductions when scoring.

SCORING

- Points range from 1 to 9.
 - Judges may award each score only once and cannot repeat scores for other participants.
 - Scoring is transparent.
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TOOLS

- Allowed Tools: Scissors, thinning shears, combs, flat brushes, beard brushes, spray bottles, clippers, trimmers, hairdryers, neck brushes, razors, shavettes, shaving brushes, bowls, towels, collars, cutting capes, alum stones.
 - Prohibited Tools: Round brushes, straighteners, curling irons, crimpers, rollers.
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PROHIBITED ELEMENTS

- Hair extensions and attachments.
 - Makeup.
 - Coloring sprays.
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COSMETICS

- Allowed Hair Cosmetics:
 - Pomades, pastes, waxes, grooming sprays, hair sprays, talcum powder.
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PENALTIES

The Control Committee monitors participants during the competition. It can assign penalties ranging from 1 to 3 points for each infraction, with the following violations penalized:

1. 1 point: Improper attire of the model.
 2. 2 points: Consulting the audience.
 3. 3 points: Hair styling not in accordance with competition regulations.
 4. 4 points: Pre-prepared hairstyles (pre-done contours or nape shapes), insufficient shortening during the competition, use of prohibited tools/cosmetics.
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DISQUALIFICATION

A participant will be disqualified for:

- Continuing work after the competition time is over.
 - Starting work before the competition begins.
 - Switching the assigned station number.
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COMPETITION TIME

40 minutes.

REGISTRATION FOR THE COMPETITION

Registration for the "Polish Hairdressing Championships" signifies acceptance of the participation regulations.

PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

The organizers inform participants that their likenesses will be captured through photos and videos during the event to document the competition. Selected materials, including photos, videos, and participants' names and school affiliations, may be used for promotional and informational purposes. They will be published on the organizers' websites, in local press, and on television.

Data Use on Facebook

2. Correspondence regarding the designated Data Protection Officer should be sent to the administrator's address.
3. The legal basis for processing personal data is the participant's consent. For underage participants, consent must be provided by a parent or legal guardian.
4. The purpose of processing data is to qualify participants for the competition, document the competition, and inform local media about the event.
5. Data recipients include authorized entities, local press, television, and the Facebook social media platform.

6. Participants have the right to access, rectify, delete, or limit the processing of their data. They may also object to data processing, request cessation of processing, or withdraw consent without affecting the legality of prior data processing.
7. Participants who believe their data is being processed unlawfully may file a complaint with the Personal Data Protection Office.
8. Providing personal data is voluntary but necessary for participation in the event.
